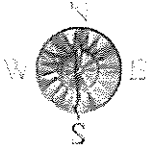

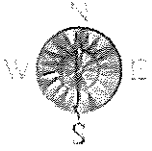

Police to investigate and report back to the next forum meeting

Following discuss the priorities identified were:-

- Coleshill Hi Vis Patrols - to combat rise in acquisitive crime and also deal with parking on the High Street and vehicles turning right onto High Street from Church Hill.
- Ansley Common particularly around Nursery Hill School and also parking obstructing pavements on Birmingham Road, Ansley Village
- Parking on the junction of Oak Avenue and Rectory Road, New Arley



4. Police & Crime Commissioner (Philip Seccombe, P&CC)

Philip Seccome, served with the Territorial Army for 25 years, commanding his Regiment and reaching the rank of Colonel. He still maintains his military connections as chairman of the West Midlands Reserve Forces and Cadets Association and as chairman of the Warwickshire Army Benevolent Fund.

His key priorities are to ensure that police are properly equipped, trained and motivated to protect the public and bring offenders to justice, while maintaining high visibility among local communities and strong support for victims of crime. He has also pledged to cut red tape and find new efficiencies enabling frontline policing to be boosted, with increased numbers of police officers, PCSOs and Specials across Warwickshire.

His term of office runs until May 2020.

A number of questions were raised regarding the current policing capacity in Coleshill. P Seccome replied that this was one of his priorities to address.

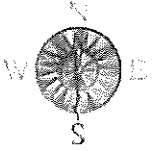
