
- 65 + Targeted patrols (target 20)
- 3 previous months, 12 reported incidents, last quarter 4 reported incidents including damage to allotments, but 13 burglaries on the allotment sheds
- Reactive units have been patrolling locations
- Officers have changed shifts to increase patrols of area
- Details have been taken of young people in the vicinity who have not returned after being warned about behaviour. None caught in act of ASB.
- 2 arrested for robbery 31/07/11
- CCTV relocated

Nuisance Motor Cycles – Sycamore Crescent, Arley

- (15 target patrols) 36 + achieved
- Residents say problem has diminished and only 5 nuisance reports made
- Promote Scooter Safe as diversionary strategy
- 1 x S 59 Notice issued
- Offenders spoken to and also those dropping off bikes
- Land Agents/owners/Councils to meet during winter months re preventative actions

- Regarding Community Speed Watch in Ansley Vetting forms have been submitted for checks, more volunteers are needed (3 or 4) and a coordinator is still required.
- Burglary Initiative CP visits all residents in Breach Oak Lane, Tippers Hill Lane, Grimstock Hill, Bennetts Road North, Sandy Lane and Shustoke
