- b That the review of the Community Support service consider how to effectively cover the 24/7

requirements of the service from the current staffing establishment; and

c That the request to use reserve funds to provide budget to cover the temporary officer be supported and reported to the Resources Board.

5 **Overtime Rates – Housing Direct Works**

The Assistant Director (Housing) reported on proposals to change the current overtime rates for Housing Direct Works tradesmen and the Sub-Group was asked to consider a suggested course of action.
