(25 agreed visits)

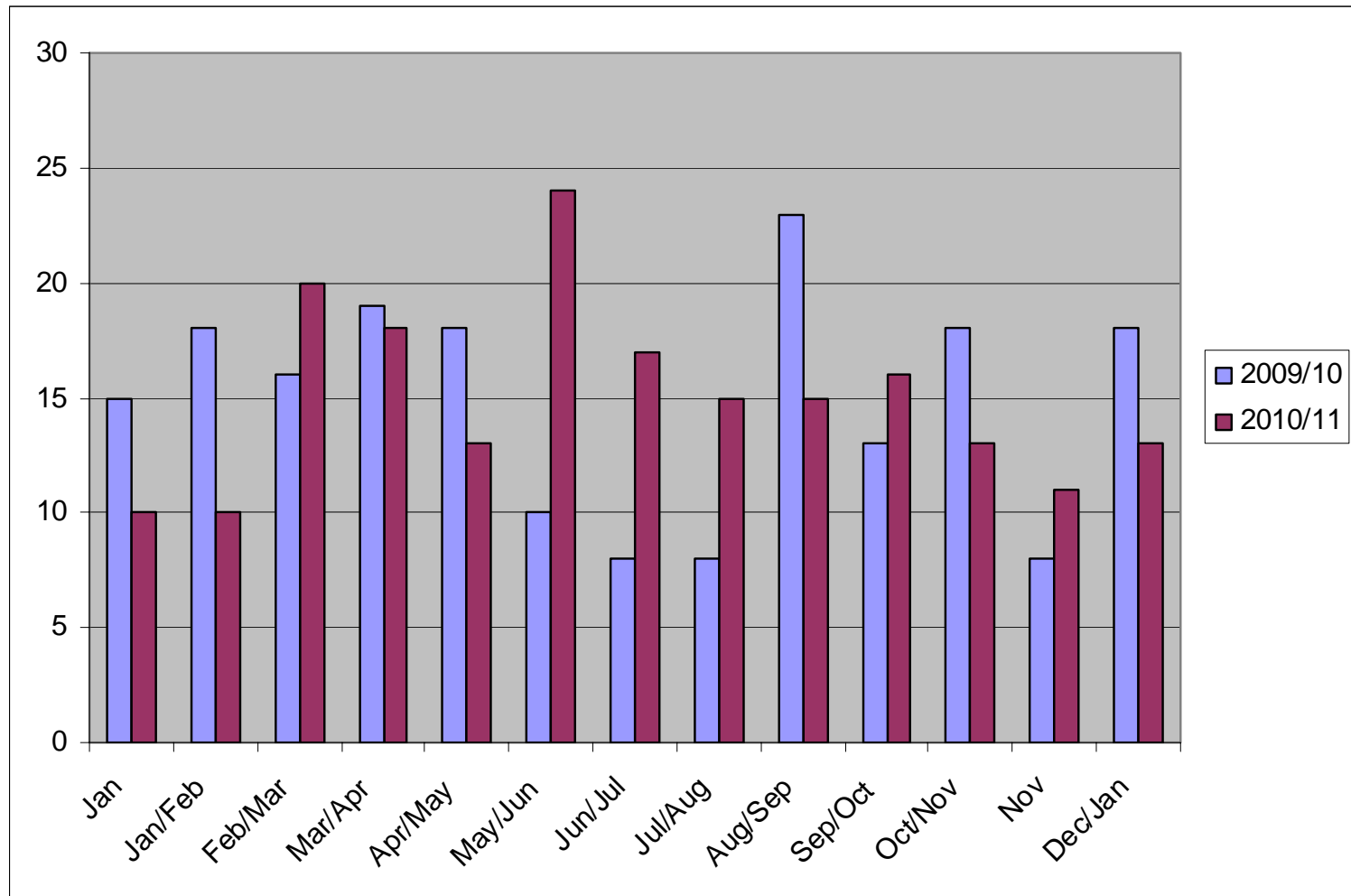
Community Priorities

ASB / Nuisance, Tannery Close Atherstone

(25 Targeted Patrols = 100 % Policing activity)

1. 40 targeted patrols conducted
2. “No Issues” reported on patrols.
3. Hat and Beaver Public House added to EPI premises list and Friday/Saturday night checks conducted.

Multi-agency meeting, discussing issues and solutions for Tannery Close

Actions:

- A leaflet to encourage residents to report all incidents
- Increased Police patrols inc Fri & Sat evenings
- Identification of land & fence owners
- Visits to local schools
- Installation of a CCTV camera



DON'T ACCEPT IT – REPORT IT

WHO TO REPORT IT TO

Report antisocial behaviour and nuisance neighbours to:

1. Warwickshire Police on **01926 415000** or at any police station.
In an emergency, or if a crime is in progress, dial 999.
2. North Warwickshire Borough Council online at: www.northwarks.gov.uk/asb if you do not require an immediate response.
Or by calling the contact centre on **01827 715341** open week days 8:30 - 20:00 and Saturdays 9:00 - 16:00.
3. Crimestoppers anonymously.

When reporting antisocial behaviour it is **helpful** if you have specific details about:

- What happened
- When
- Where
- Who was involved
- How you and others were affected by it.

If necessary keep a diary.

ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR DON'T ACCEPT IT – REPORT IT

WHAT IS ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR?

It's behaviour that causes alarm, distress or harassment to you, your friends and family. Examples include:

Graffiti Litter Fly tipping Noise nuisance Hoax calls
Animal related problems Rowdy or nuisance behaviour
Abandoned cars Begging Intimidation or harassment
Sexual acts Vandalism Street drinking Prostitution
Inappropriate vehicle use Kerb crawling Drug misuse/dealing



WHY REPORT IT?

Antisocial behaviour can ruin lives. Information you provide enables action to be taken.

TAKING ACTION

Action can be initiated by a number of agencies. This can include:

- Warning letters and interviews
- Acceptable behaviour contracts
- Parenting orders, individual support orders, noise abatement notices, injunctions, dispersal powers and antisocial behaviour orders (ASBOs)
- Possession proceedings against a tenant.

We need information in order to take action.



Licensed Premise Visits (Violent Crime Reduction Plan)

Atherstone Town Centre.

(40 visits = 100% agreed Policing activity)

1. 43 Licensing visits conducted
2. Review of one town centre premise licence in November.
Licence revoked.
3. Recorded Violent Crime for Town Centre beats :


October, 1 st to 31 st	3 offences
November, 1 st to 30 th	4 offences
December, 1 st to 31 st	0 offences

Parking, area of Long Street, Atherstone.

(25 patrols = 100 % agreed Policing activity)

1. 28 targeted patrols conducted
2. 14 fixed penalties issued
3. 80 persons advised
4. 64 advisory letters generated

Still an issue, that will not be resolved unless
Civil Parking Enforcement is adopted.
