DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4

NORTH WARWICKSHIRE BOROUGH COUNCIL

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS, 1977-1981

WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of North Warwickshire, being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977 are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on land at Parsonage Farm, Great Packington in the County of Warwick, as shown edged red on the scale 1:2500 and 1:10560 plans annexed hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977;

AND WHEREAS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said description would be prejudicial to the proper planning of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 should apply to this direction;

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1977 shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto.

THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until the 24th December, 1981 and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

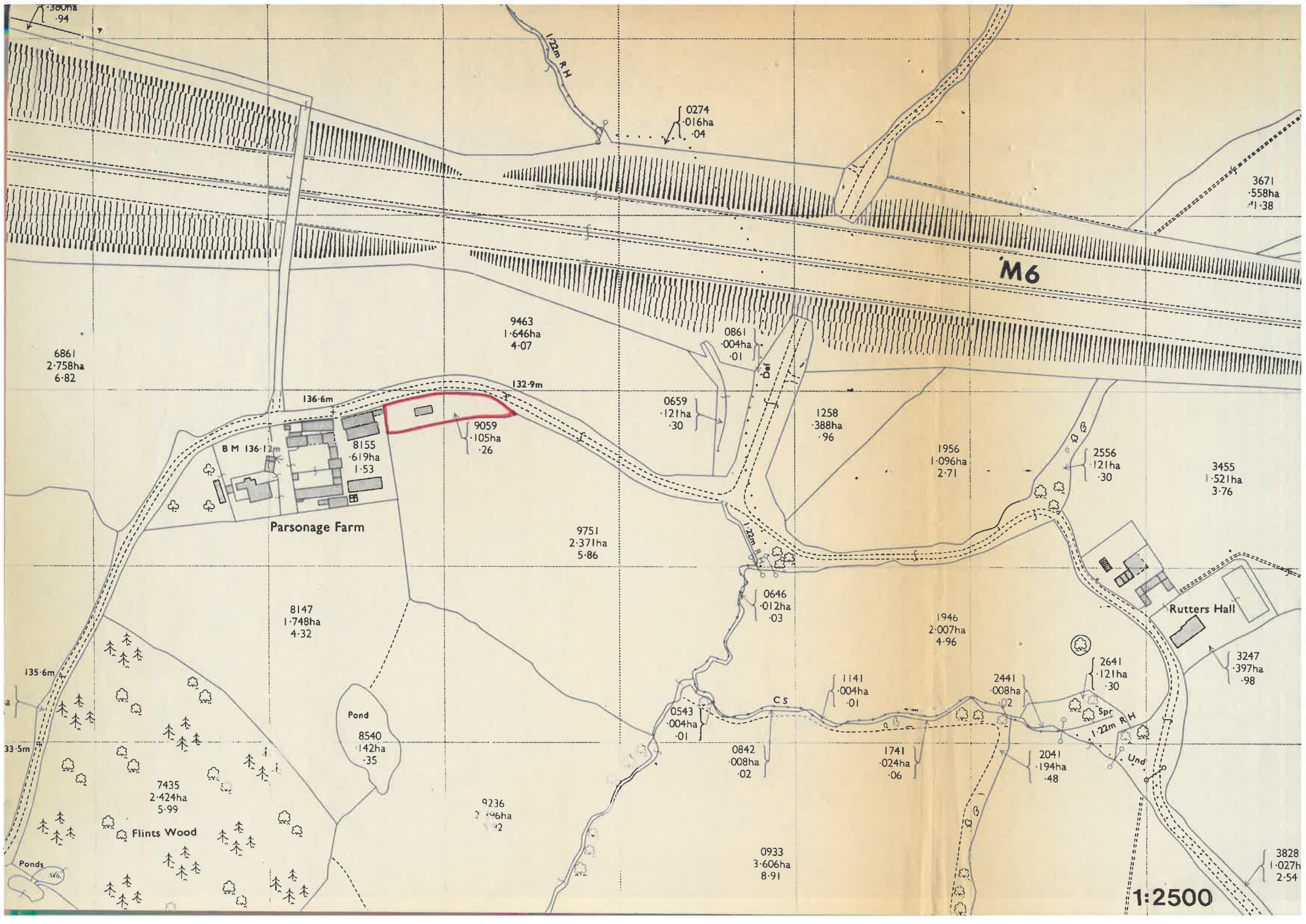
