



NOTICE OF MAKING OF PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER

Notice is hereby given that North Warwickshire Borough Council ('the council') in exercise of its powers under section 59, 60, 61 and 72 of the above Act and under all other enabling powers, has made a Public Spaces Protection Order to prevent anti-social behaviour arising from dog fouling within the Borough. A copy of the Order may be seen free of charge at The Council House, South Street, Atherstone CV9 1DE, or on North Warwickshire Borough Council's website.

The Order comes into force on 4 March 2024 but an interested person (an individual living in the restricted area or who regularly works in or visits that area) may question the validity of the public spaces protection order on the grounds that the local authority did not have power to make the order, or to include particular prohibitions or requirements imposed by the order, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014, by applying to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 68 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 within 8 weeks from the date on which the Order is made
